

Hurricane Harvey hits Texas coast and is being called the most powerful U.S. hurricane in over a decade!

Over a dozen tornadoes have been reported, and flooding is causing wide spread devastation, uprooting fully mature trees, and business and homes are being destroyed.

Hurricane Harvey is expected to produce winds over 70 mph, total rain accumulations of 15 to 30 inches and isolated maximum amounts of 40 inches over the middle and upper Texas coast. Currently 300,000 people are without power.

During the same time period Harvey is expected to produce total rain accumulations of 5 to 15 inches in far

Immediate needs are for support of the local Disaster Rapid Response Teams, Disaster Case Management services, cash gift cards for families, temporary shelter and eventually the House in a Box® Program (90-120 days at a minimum out) the above are the most critical.
